

OS Pro Dreamer / Cyber Panel Replacement



This is the replacement of the panels for the Cyber/Dreamer. To begin you will first need a zip tie or a paper clip to undo the seat padding that is attached to the footrest. You will find the zipper head removed and that is completely normal. Our company has the zipper head removed because it is a safety precaution.



Once you have the padd unzipped you can lift it up. It might be difficult and feel like you're ripping the seat cover off but it's only the velcro that is holding it down and in place.



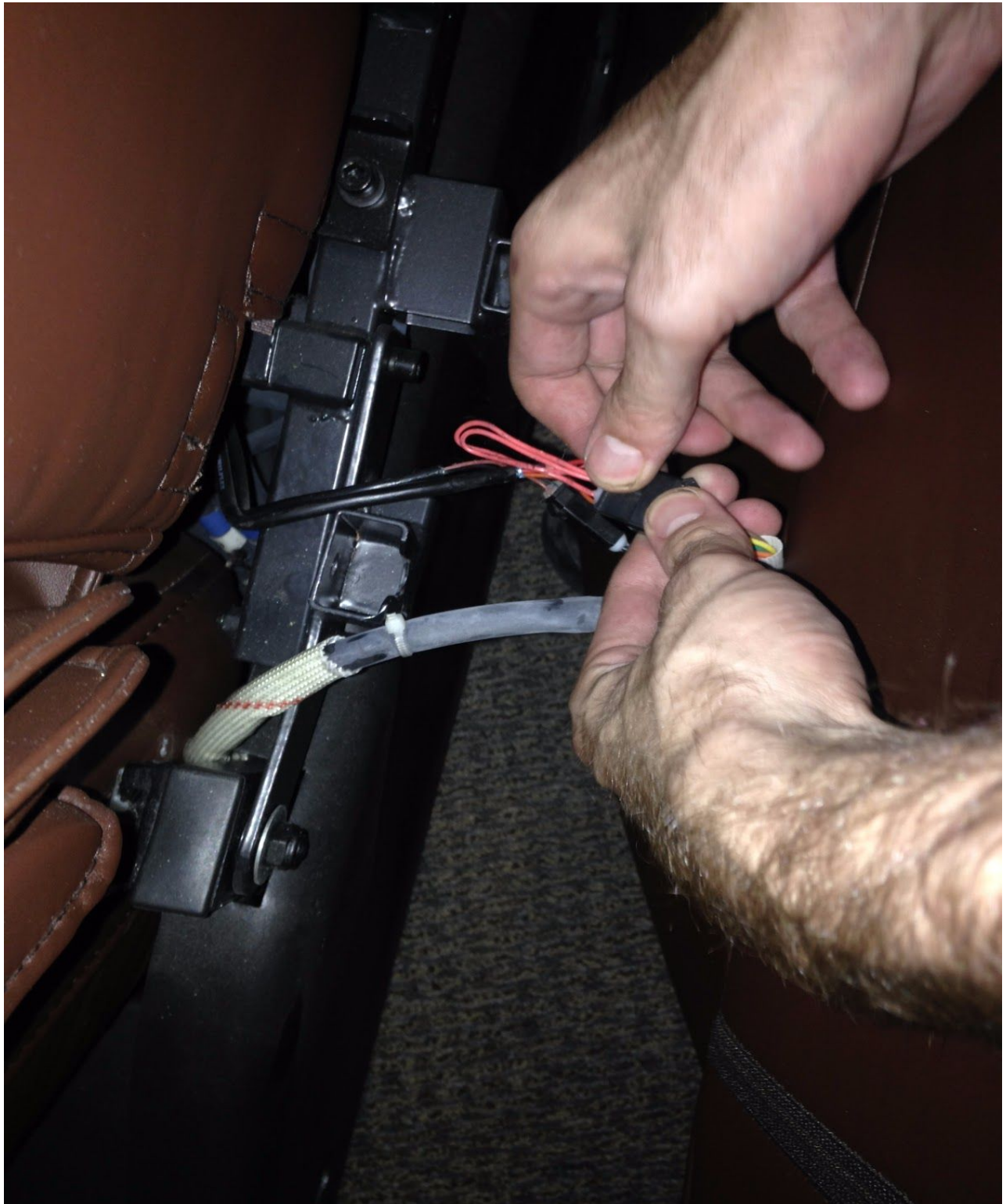
At this point you will need the allen head wrench so you can find the screws for the panel for each side. For this model there is 2 on each side.

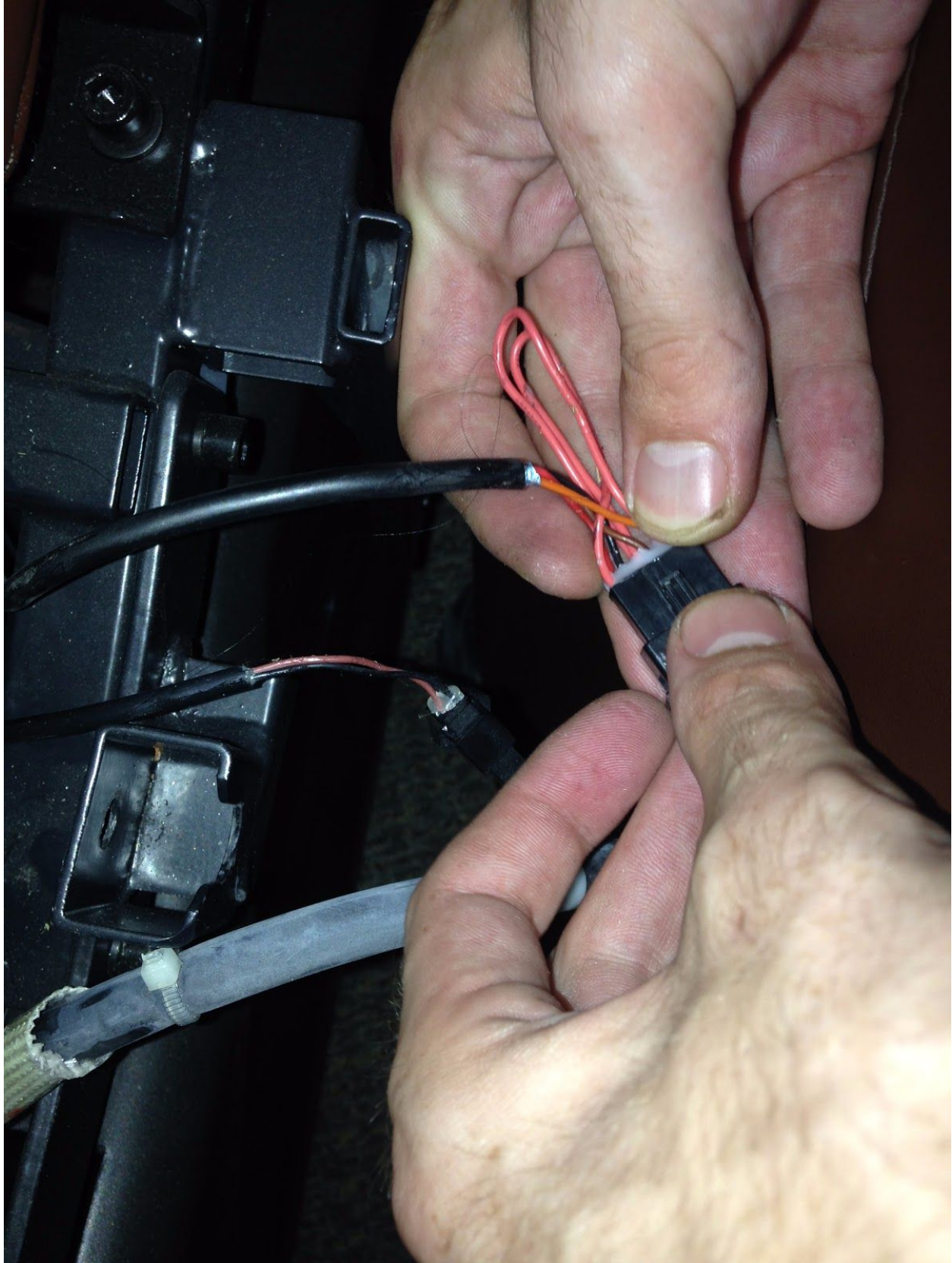


The other two are more difficult to find but you will find them towards the backrest. Look for a allen head just like the others and you will be able to unscrew it.

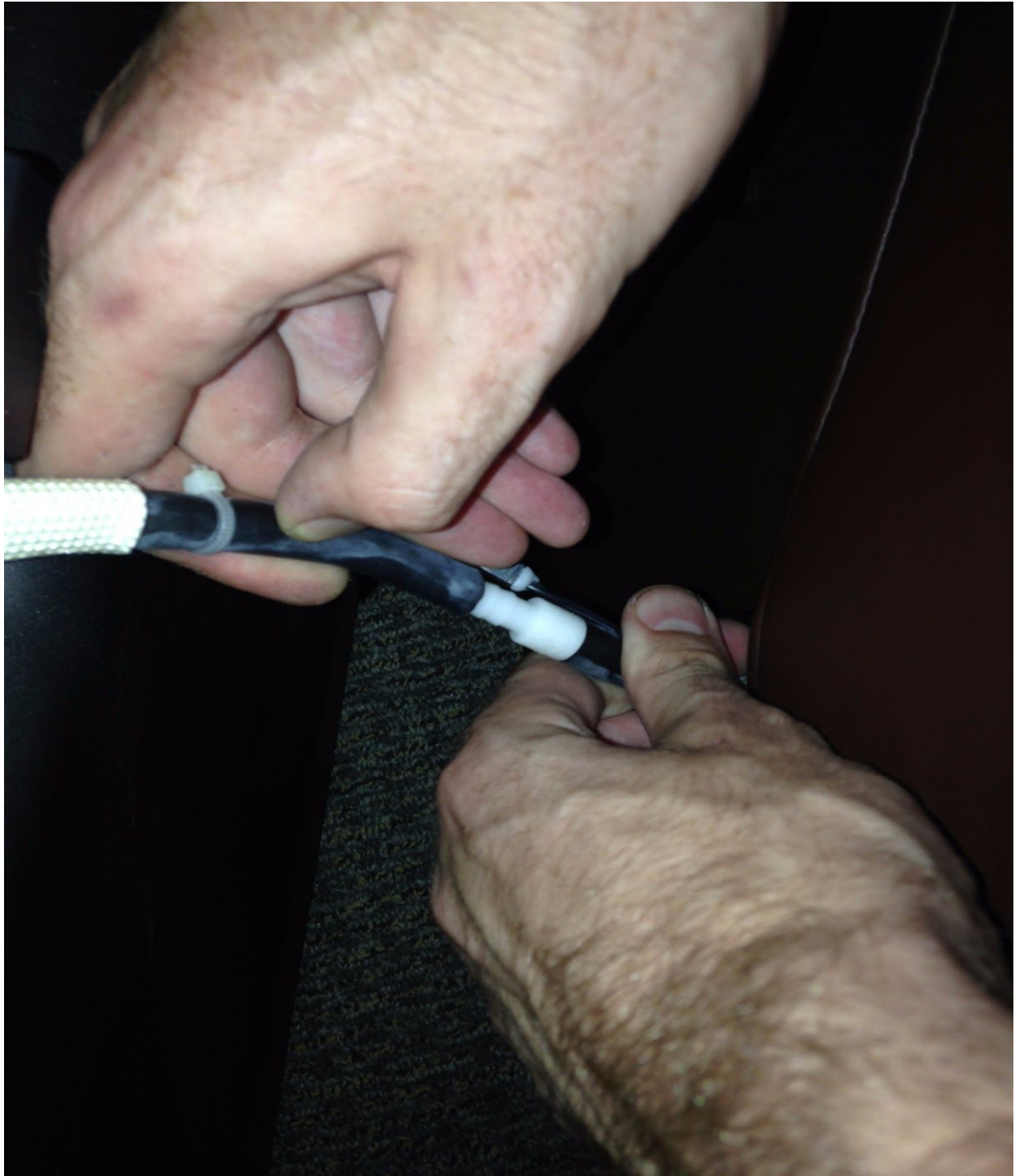


Once you have all four bolts unscrewed you will be able to lift the panels right up. ONLY lift the panels up a few inches and you will be able to set them down vertically and remove the air hoses and the two electrical wires for the side panel.





Once you have the two electrical wires you will need to disconnect the air hose. Be careful not to rip the air hose apart. Look for the white tube connector and pull the part apart from there. Once you have that part found you can disconnect everything.



This is what you should be looking at once the panels are removed. You can easily replace the panels from here. Make sure the holes are aligned and that all the air hoses and wires attached firmly.





Also make sure that the hooks that attach the panel to the chair are firmly attached to the base.
